Manufacture

Hardware

Project in Focus

University Challenge



When Sheffield Hallam University acquired the city's former museum of pop for its new Students Union building it gave itself quite a challenge to refurbish this circular structure. The design brief called for a solution that would be robust enough to withstand the rigours of student life but flexible enough to follow the gentle curves of the building.

Main contractor, Barlow's, awarded the contract to fit out the toilet areas to Inscape Cubicles and Washrooms based on the fact that Inscape could bring a unique approach whilst maintaining a competitive bid. Inscape offered a solution which encompassed the manufacture and supply of the cubicles, vanity units and duct panel systems. Installation was carried out by Inscape's specialist site teams. Added to this Inscape not only provided all the sanitary ware and associated fittings, but also completed the first fix plumbing and made the final connections using its in-house plumbing team. One company - one solution.

The female toilets on the ground floor comprised a range of cubicles on an internal curved profile with a range of vanity units opposite on an external curve.

On the first floor a range of cubicles and urinals were built on an internal curve, with a small number of vanity units opposite on an external curve. These facilities were complimented with a central curved island comprising additional urinals to the outer curve and further vanity units to the internal curve. A sloping ceiling further complicated these shapes! The curves were achieved by faceting the various components and using triangular flash gaps to complete the junction of one unit to another. The head rails over the cubicles were achieved by forming aluminium extrusions on site as the curves progressed.

The Inscape Extremus range of cubicles and vanity units was specified. Manufactured from compact grade laminate this system provides excellent resistance to wear & tear and moisture. The sanitaryware, cisterns and flushing systems were supplied by Inscape's partners, Laufen and Geberit respectively. In order to ensure that the vanity bowls would withstand the force of students sitting upon them additional reinforcement was supplied to the framing with the bowls being fixed with through bolts. Two separate disabled facilities were also fully fitted by Inscape.

By utilising Inscapes unique offer, Barlow's and Sheffield Hallam were able to ensure that the co-ordination of all the key washroom elements, cubicles, vanities, duct panels, sanitaryware and plumbing were under one specialist subcontractors control. This approach has been proven to ensure that projects are completed on time, to specification and within budget.
